Doing a simple google search on the topic will result in many more titles that you and your child may find interesting.

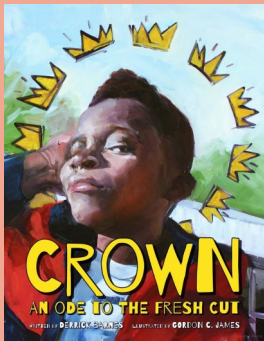


Smart Sisters by Mechal Renee Roe

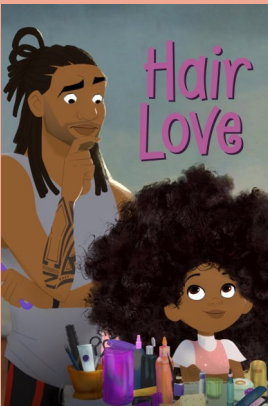
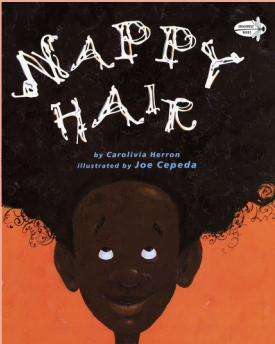


Crown: An Ode to the Fresh Cut by Derrick Barnes
